ICLOPS 17: Rate of Follow Up Visits Within 7 Days of Discharge (Including Physician Response)

Measure Description

This is a two-part measure, measuring whether patients were seen in a timely fashion in the ambulatory setting after discharge. Physician feedback is required to satisfy requirements. Patients will be assigned to a physician's Registry based on identification within the Hospital Quality dataset. The patient will be matched to existing patient data within this physician's source system using the standard Roji Health Intelligence patient-matching algorithm. Patients within the data who cannot be matched to patients within the physician source system data will be displayed, but flagged for review and validation.

- Performance Rate 1 the percentage of discharges where there is a subsequent office visit within seven days out of the total number of all-cause discharges for patients aged 18 years and older.
- Performance Rate 2 is the percentage of discharges without subsequent office visits within 7 days where clinician provided required feedback AND where re-admission within 30 days did not occur, out of the total number of all-cause discharges for patients aged 18 years and older.
- Overall Performance Rate = (Part 1 Performance Met + Part 2 Performance Met) / (Part 1 Performance Eligible + Part 2 Performance Eligible).

Measure Numerator

Part 1: Discharge where there is an office visit within seven days

Part 2: Discharges without subsequent office visits in seven days, where the clinician provided required feedback AND where patient was not re-admitted within 30 days.

Feedback options are as follows:

- Office did not respond to discharge planning requests
- Patient not followed locally
- Patient seen by non-participating physician within 7 day
- Patient unable to get office visit scheduled
- Patient/caregiver did not follow instructions
- Patient/caregiver not instructed on visit
- None of the above

Measure Denominator

Part 1: All-cause discharges for patients aged 18 years and older

Part 2: All-cause discharges for patients aged 18 years and older AND discharges where there was no ambulatory follow up within seven days

Denominator Exceptions/Exclusions

Denominator Exceptions:

- Part 1: Patients with an in-hospital death
- Part 1: Patients transferred to another acute care facility

Performance Calculation

This measure has two performance rates. Overall performance is calculated as follows:

Overall Performance Rate = (Part 1 Performance Met + Part 2 Performance Met) / (Part 1 Performance Eligible + Part 2 Performance Eligible)
